The objective of the PEPPOL project is to set up a pan-European pilot solution that, conjointly with existing national solutions, facilitates EU-wide interoperable public eProcurement.

The vision of the PEPPOL project is that any company and in particular SMEs in the EU can communicate electronically with any European governmental institution for the entire procurement process. Furthermore - the exchange of business documents should be as easy as sending emails.

It is our ambition that the PEPPOL infrastructure will be used for many different purposes (also outside eProcurement) and will be rolled out in all member states after a successful pilot.

## GETTING THERE

**By plane:** Fly to Kastrup (Copenhagen International Airport) Take the train from the arrival terminal: Öresundståg trains stop at Malmö Central Station, and St Gertrud Konferens is 5 minutes' walk away

From Sturup (Malmö Airport)  
Airport coaches: Stops at Central Station and Studentgatan  
By car: Malmö Airport is about 30 km from Malmö

### From Malmö Central Station

Approximately 5 minutes' walk from Malmö Central Station.

- 13 minutes by Pågatåg/Öresundståg trains from Lund
- 20 minutes by Öresundståg trains from Kastrup/Copenhagen
- 40 minutes by Pågatåg/Öresundståg trains from Helsingborg

### By car

- E6 European Highway from the north, from Stockholm/Oslo/Gothenburg
- E22 European Highway from the north, from Lund

Head for Malmö Centrum. Turn right at the first traffic lights, then immediately right again towards Slussplan - on Norra Vallgatan. Take the third left after the canal bridge and then immediately right. Alternatively, carry on 200 metres on Norra Vallgatan and look for a black sign on the right showing S:t Gertrud.

- E20 European Highway from the west, from Copenhagen/Denmark
- After the bridge Öresundsbron, take left to Kalkbrottsgatan and then right to Limhamnsvägen. Follow Citadellsvägen, and take right to the canal bridge. Turn left on Norra Vallgatan. Carry on to Norra Vallgatan 16 and the black sign showing S:t Gertrud.
